

## To Heaven and Back by Mary C. Neal, M.D. Self-Published Phenomenon Now #1 New York Times Bestseller A Spinal Surgeon's Dramatic Account of her Death and Visit to Heaven



Colorado Springs, Colo. - To Heaven and Back: A Doctor's Extraordinary Account of Her Death, Heaven, Angels and Life Again: A True Story by Dr. Mary C. Neal reached the #1 spot on the New York Times bestseller list within weeks of its May 24, 2012 release by WaterBrook Multnomah, a division of Random House, Inc. The book contains a dramatic first-hand account by an orthopaedic spinal surgeon of her accidental death by drowning, visit to heaven, and subsequent return to physical life. The title has become a national word-of-mouth phenomenon since it was originally self-published in November 2011.

Consumer demand for *To Heaven and Back* has been spurred by strong national media interest in Dr. Neal's story. In the weeks before the book's release, she appeared on Fox News Channel's "Fox and Friends," the #1 rated cable news morning show, and on "Live with Megyn Kelly." Dr. Neal also shared her story during a two-hour interview on the nationally syndicated radio show "Coast to Coast AM," and was a subject in Jay Leno's monologue on the May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012 edition of "The Tonight"

Show," when he lightheartedly made a reference to Mary Neal's book and the possibility of life after death for the NBC Network. Within days, the self-published edition of *To Heaven and Back* was ranked # 5 at BarnesandNoble.com and # 29 at Amazon.com.

In *To Heaven and Back*, Dr. Neal recounts how she drowned on a remote South American river after her kayak was caught under a waterfall for almost fifteen minutes. During this time, Dr. Neal was held and comforted by God before spiritual beings appeared and brought her to heaven. She conversed with angels and, despite her overwhelming desire to stay in heaven, was told that she had more work to do on earth and must return to her body. She returned, in part, to tell her remarkable story to others and help them find their way back to God.
