

Liz Curtis Higgs Rocks Real-World Readers With A High-Spirited Walk through the Book of Ruth



Colorado Springs, Colo.—*New York Times* bestselling author **Liz Curtis Higgs** uses her rich storytelling talents and sound biblical knowledge in *The Girl's Still Got It* (WaterBrook Press, July 10, 2012) to transport readers back more than 3,000 years to the ancient lands of Moab and Bethlehem and the days of Naomi, Ruth and Boaz in a novel approach to Bible study.

In her first non-fiction book in five years, popular Bible teacher and speaker Higgs takes readers behind the scenes with two of the leading ladies of the Old Testament, Naomi and Ruth, to tarry in the corners of their ancient houses, listen to their conversations, and consider every word of every verse of *Ruth* until readers can say, “I *totally* get the book of Ruth. And I see what God is trying to teach me through this rags-to-riches redemption story—he has a plan for my life.”

The Girl's Still Got It paints a portrait of the young widow Ruth, her mother-in-law and their kinsman-redeemer to illustrate what they can teach about God's steadfast love. Although He doesn't have a speaking role or make a physical appearance in the book of Ruth, God's presence is constant and as steady as a heartbeat. Higgs writes, “When we reach the final page of Ruth's story, I hope that instead of saying, ‘Wow, what a woman!’ we'll be saying, ‘Wow, what a Redeemer!’”

Designed for personal or group study, *The Girl's Still Got It* includes both a discussion guide and chapter-by-chapter Bible study. Also available is a companion DVD of *The Girl's Still Got It* with two hours of engaging teaching, filmed before a live audience, where Higgs uses her trademark humor and heartfelt encouragement to unpack the book of Ruth and drive home the message of God's sovereignty and grace.
