

conviction, upholding the tenants of the faith and community she holds dear. Yet the story truly begins 20 years ago, on a night filled with fear and expectation, as Ariana's mother struggles to give birth as the birthing center erupts in flames around her. On the same night, a pregnant Englisch woman passing through the town, unexpectedly goes into labor and rushes to the center to give birth to her daughter, Skylar.

What follows is an intricately woven tale of the lives of two young women, living worlds apart, yet undeniably joined by that single night. What will Ariana and Skylar discover about their birth and will it threaten to unravel the only lives they've ever known?
