DISCUSSION GUIDE**

Week 1: “Leading with Integrity”

Reading: Chapters 1–2

Discussion Questions:

1. What are some current challenges in church leadership that you have observed? How can discernment help in identifying true church leaders?
2. What are the biblical qualifications for church leaders as outlined in 1 Timothy 3:1–7 and Titus 1:5–9? How do these characteristics impact the church community?
3. What are some examples of false teachings you have encountered? How can church leaders and congregants work together to uphold the truth?
4. How can we as a congregation support and hold our leaders accountable? What practical steps can we take to encourage integrity in our church leadership?

Week 2: “An Empowered Congregation”

Reading: Chapter 3–4

Discussion Questions:

1. What does the Bible say about the role of the congregation in supporting church leadership? How can we foster a culture of mutual accountability?
2. Why is community important in the church? How can we practice mutual accountability within our church?
3. What are some ways we can actively participate in church life? How can we encourage others to get involved?
4. What steps can we take to engage more deeply in our church community? How can we support each other in our spiritual growth?

Week 3: “Mastering the Scriptures”

Reading: Chapters 5–6

Discussion Questions:

1. Why is biblical literacy important for both leaders and congregants? What are some challenges to achieving biblical literacy?
2. What are the dangers of ignorance and the importance of sound doctrine? How can we guard against false teachings?
3. What are some effective ways to study the Bible? How can we encourage each other to grow in our understanding of the Scriptures?
4. What commitment can we make to regular Bible study? How can we support each other in this commitment?

Week 4: “Living Out the Gospel”

Reading: Chapters 7–8

Discussion Questions:

1. What does it mean to be an ambassador for Christ? How can we represent Christ in our daily lives?
2. What are some practical ways to live out the gospel in our daily lives? How can we share the love of Christ with others?
3. How can we engage with our community in meaningful ways? What are some opportunities for outreach and service in our area?
4. How can we be intentional about representing Christ in our daily lives? What steps can we take to make a positive impact in our community?

Week 5: “Building a Thriving Church”

Reading: Chapters 9–10

Discussion Questions:

1. Why is a healthy church community important? What are some characteristics of a healthy church?
2. How can leadership contribute to building a healthy church community? What role does each member play in this process?
3. How can we work together to build a strong, supportive community? What are some practical steps we can take to foster unity and cooperation?
4. What commitment can we make to building a healthy church community? How can we support each other in this commitment?
