Many people think of a half hour as a minimal or meaningless gap in time. But the truth is that your half hours can determine the difference between success and failure. You literally can change your world in thirty minutes.



- To accept the idea
- Have a clear sense of your God-given purpose
- Examine your activity patterns
- Sensitize yourself to your time choices
- Start taking advantage of the power of a half hour

Every half-hour in your day is a power loaded resource.

If you get your half hours right, God will not only change your life but use you to alter the lives of the people and organizations you influence.

Here are a few reasons why thirty minutes can impact your life and help chart out your life path:

1. Thirty minutes can wreck or redeem a life.

30 minutes can change your destiny

David made a life changing decision and acted on that decision within a thirty-minute time frame. He altered his destiny along with Bathsheba's destiny.

The woman caught in adultery was forgiven and her life was saved within a thirty-minute time frame.

Jesus altered her destiny and redeemed her life.

I bet that if you were to make a list of significant choices you've made within half hour periods, you would be surprised at how much your life has been influenced by these thirty-minute time blocks.

2. Thirty minute investments produce huge returns When God gave us the gift of time, he intended for us to use it wisely and productively.

You are honoring God's plan and blessing Him with the fruit of your life when you use your time well.

How we use our time is important to God. If we are faithful with small things, He will give us greater things...

Matthew 25:14-30

Luke 16:10

Psalm 39:4-5

Nobody can eliminate the results of time well invested.

Focused attention is the essence of powerful half hours.

Focused attention is understanding the value of even the smallest increments of time and using those minutes intentionally.

In the space of time of a half hour, amazing things can happen in your life.

God will use your half hours in incredible ways if you just let Him!

God created every person to do a special thing that He needs done on earth. If we don't do our part then our part won't be done exactly the way God intended. God will accomplish His will, but if we aren't living in our purpose then we will miss out on the opportunity to play an important role in that will.

God's unique plan for you relates to your life vision and purpose.



The only way to get God's vision for your life is to spend time humbled in His presence until He chooses to reveal it to you. God often implants His vision in your heart and mind within focused half hours spent with Him.

After you receive and embrace God's vision for your life, pursue that vision.

Pursue God's vision for your life by...

Aligning your values with God's values.

What's really important to you?

What really matters in life is what's important to God.

His values need to be our values.

What is there to life but serving God and serving people?

Sharpening your gifts and abilities

God has blessed you with a variety of gifts and abilities.

Those talents become strategic and influential when you invest in developing and sharpening them.

You must cultivate spiritual gifts through...

Study

Samuel, David, Peter and Paul are all examples of people who cultivated their spiritual gifts One way to grow your gifts, talents and abilities is to observe others who possess similar capacities.
Strengthening your faith You can strengthen your faith by
(1) A. Making a regular connection

B. Be honest and transparent with God

With some focused attention, some amazing creativity can be birthed in a half hour.

SUSTAIN HOPE

Take a half hour to reflect on God's plan for you.

Take kingdom risks.

If the Lord puts the opportunity before you and the idea in your mindpursue it!
Use your half hours to risk wisely, and you will make a real difference in your world.
