Invite friends to read the picture book, *Holy Night and Little Star* with you

Make a **star-themed** family ornament for your Christmas tree

What was the big news that spread through space in the book? Why did Little Star want things to stay the same?

Tell someone, who might need courage, the story of Little Star who said "yes" to Maker

Attend a candlelight service with family and friends

Start the Holy Night and Little Star 5-day reading plan on Bible.com or YouVersion app

Bake star-shaped cookies and decorate them to look like Little Star

Why was Holy Night, the night the Child was born, so important?

Gift homemade cookies to a friend or neighbor

Watch the animated movie "The Star"

Read Psalm 147:4

"He determines the number of the stars; he gives to all of them their names."

Draw a picture of Little Star or your favorite scene from Holy Night and Little Star

Who was the Child in Holy Night and Little Star?

Write a Christmas card to someone who might be celebrating this season alone

Sing the song "O Holy Night" and play it on a musical instrument if you know one

Read Isaiah 9:6-7

"A child is born to us! A son is given to us! And he will be our ruler."

Make star-shaped **paper** snowflakes and hang them around your room or home

What gave Little Star **courage** in the book?

Serve at your local homeless shelter

Take a walk to see **Christmas** light displays around your neighborhood or city

Read Psalm 148:3

"Praise him, sun and moon; praise him, all you shining stars!"

Wrap and decorate gifts with stars on them

Like Little Star in the book, what can you do that feels brave this week?

Donate to a local charity, food bank, or toy drive

Write a liturgy about courage and saying "yes" to God this season
