Directions:


- Print the next page on white card stock paper.
- Cut out the wheel and arrow.
- Align the arrow over the center dot on the wheel.
- Punch a hole through the arrow and wheel.
- Secure the arrow with a round-head fastener. Tape the back of the fastener onto the wheel to keep it in place.



- · You can find round-head fasteners in your local office supplies store.
- · Try gluing the wheel onto a paper plate for variation!
- · you may also laminate the materials before assembly.
